## **Harry Page Architectural Photography Competition**

### **Preamble**

The Harry Page photography competition was founded in 2013 in memory of C20 Society member and keen photographer Harry Page. It will be an annual event, closing on 30<sup>th</sup> September each year. Judging will take place after that date with the winner's trophy being awarded during the C20 Society autumn lecture series. The winner will return the trophy in time for the following year's prize giving.

### **Rules**

1. Only C20 Society members may submit entries.
2. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that they read and abide by these rules and the submission guidelines.
3. Entries must be submitted to the competition administrator either digitally on the dedicated Flickr group, by email to sarah@sarahjduncan or by post. Postal entries should be sent as prints (minimum size 7 x 5 inches) to Harry Page Photo competition, C20 Society, 70 Cowcross Street, London EC1M 6EJ. All entries should include your C20 Society membership number, and images should be captioned with the name and location of the building, and the architect's name if known.
4. The competition runs from 1 October to 30 September each year.
5. Images from digital cameras or camera phones can be submitted but must have been taken using a sufficiently high resolution: we recommend that you use a camera of 6 mega pixels or more and employ the highest quality setting. Images which have been scanned from transparencies or negatives are eligible. A maximum of 25 images per entrant may be submitted, either in black and white or colour.
6. Please ensure that you keep copies of submitted images. The Society cannot take responsibility for loss or damage to prints submitted. Entries may be used for C20 Society publicity and, by entering the competition, you grant C20 Society a licence to reproduce any image you submit for any purpose in connection with the competition.
7. All entries will be assessed by a judging panel including Tim McCoy-Page and a representative of the C20 Society. The panel's decision will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
8. The winner will be notified by email or phone and the trophy presentation will be held during the annual lecture series in The Gallery, 70 Cowcross Street, London EC1M 6EJ.

9. Entries must have been taken by the entrant and may be of any building or architectural feature from the period covered by the C20 Society: buildings completed from 1914.
10. By submitting entries, each entrant confirms that:
  - a. They are the sole author of each entry and it is their own original work
  - b. They own the copyright and any other intellectual rights in each image
  - c. They have the prior permission of any people depicted in each image
  - d. They have not licensed or otherwise disposed of any rights in any image
  - e. They have received any necessary permission from the owners of the building depicted.
11. Employees of the C20 Society or those involved with the administration or judging of the prize are not eligible to enter.
