# JAEGER

No 4135

5p

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**5th row**—Cast off 2 [2, 2, 2] sts., work to end.

**6th row**—Work to end.

**7th row**—Dec. 1 st., work to the last 2 sts., dec. 1 st.

**8th row**—Work to end.

**9th row**—Dec. 1 st., work to end.

**10th row**—Work to end.

Rep. 7th to 10th rows once more, and then 7th and 8th rows once.

Work 2 rows.

Now keeping armhole edge straight, continue to dec. for front slope on the next row, and then every 4th row until there are 21 [22, 24, 24] sts. left.

Work until armhole measures 8½ [8½, 8½, 8½] in. from beg. measured straight, ending at armhole edge.

#### Shape shoulder

Keeping neck edge straight, cast off at beg. of next and alternate rows at shoulder edge. 7 [7, 8; 8] sts. once, 7 [8, 8, 8] sts. once and 7 [7, 8, 8] sts. once.

#### RIGHT FRONT

Work pocket lining as for left front.

Now with No. 9 needles and M., cast on 58 [61, 64, 67] sts.

**1st row**—(sizes 32 and 36 only) \* K.1, P.1, rep. from \* to the last 2 sts., K.2.

**1st row**—(sizes 34 and 38 only) K.2, \* P.1, K.1, rep. from \* to the last st., K.1.

**2nd row**—(sizes 32 and 36 only) As 1st row.

**2nd row**—(sizes 34 and 38 only) \* K.1, P.1, rep. from \* to the last st., K.1.

Work 6 more rows in this way.

#### Change to No. 8 needles and patt.

For sizes 34 and 38 only, work in patt. as for front of slipover.

For sizes 32 and 36 only, reverse the patt. so that the half patt. is at centre front edge to match the left front.

Work 30 rows.

Work pocket in next 2 rows as follows:—

**Next row**—Patt. 46 [49, 52, 55] sts., slip last 31 sts. just worked on to a st.-holder, patt. to end.

**Following row**—Patt. to end, working pocket lining sts. in place of those on st.-holder.

Now complete to match left front, reversing all shapings.

#### BACK

With No. 9 needles and M., cast on 115 [121, 127, 133] sts.

**1st row**—K.2, \* P.1, K.1, rep. from \* to the last st., K.1.

**2nd row**—\* K.1, P.1, rep. from \* to the last st., K.1.

Rep. 1st and 2nd rows 3 times more.  
Change to No. 8 needles and patt. as for front of slipover.

Work 40 rows.

Dec. 1 st. at each end of the next row, and then every 22nd row until there are 109 [115, 121, 127] sts. left.

Work until back measures same as fronts up to commencement of armhole shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape armholes and complete as for back of slipover.

#### POCKET BORDERS

Slip the 31 sts. from st.-holder on to a No. 11 needle and join in M. yarn.

**1st row**—(wrong side) P.

**2nd row**—K.2, \* P.1, K.1, rep. from \* to the last st., K.1.

**3rd row**—\* K.1, P.1, rep. from \* to the last st., K.1.

Rep. 2nd and 3rd rows 3 times more.

Cast off in rib.

#### ARMHOLE BORDERS

Work as slipover.

#### FRONT BORDER

With No. 11 needles and M., cast on 9 sts.

**Next row**—(K.1, K. into front and back of next st.) 4 times; K.1 (13 sts.).

**Continue in rib**

**1st row**—K.2, \* P.1, K.1, rep. from \* to the last st., K.1.

**2nd row**—\* K.1, P.1, rep. from \* to the last st., K.1.

These 2 rows form the rib.

Work 6 more rows.

Make buttonhole in the next 2 rows by casting off the 3 centre sts. in the first row and casting them on again in the next.

Work 28 rows.

Make buttonhole in next 2 rows.

Make 3 more buttonholes (5 in all) with 28 rows between each.

Work until border is long enough to fit along front and neck edges.

Cast off firmly in rib.

#### TO MAKE UP

Sew side seams, including armhole borders.

Sew neatly round pocket linings on the wrong side.

Sew side edges of pocket borders to fronts.

Sew border to front and neck edges.

Press seams.

Sew on buttons.

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# Slipover and Sleeveless Jacket in Jaeger Celtic-spun

To fit a 32 [34, 36, 38] in. bust. Instructions for larger sizes are given in square brackets.

## Materials

### Slipover

3 [3, 3, 3] (50g) balls in main colour,  
2 [2, 2, 2] (50g) balls in first contrasting colour and  
2 [2, 2, 2] (50g) balls in second contrasting colour  
of Jaeger Celtic-spun or Jaeger Donegal

1 pair each Milward disc knitting needles Nos. 8 and 11, USA sizes 5 and 7.

A set of 4 Milward disc No. 11 double pointed knitting needles.

### Sleeveless Jacket

4 [4, 4, 4] (50g) balls in main colour,  
2 [2, 2, 3] (50g) balls in first contrasting colour and  
2 [2, 2, 2] (50g) balls in second contrasting colour  
of Jaeger Celtic-spun or Jaeger Donegal

1 pair each Milward disc knitting needles Nos. 8, 9 and 11.

USA sizes 5, 6 and 7.  
5 buttons.

## Measurements

### Slipover

Length from shoulder 22 [22, 22, 22½] in.

### Sleeveless Jacket

Length from shoulder 27½ [27½, 27½, 27½] in.

## Tension

In width 6½ sts. to 1 in.

In depth 7½ rows to 1 in.

## Note

Knitters should test tension before commencing garment and change to a larger or smaller size needle if necessary.

## Abbreviations

K = knit; P = purl; st. = stitch; sts. = stitches; M = main colour; A = first contrasting colour; B = second contrasting colour; rep. = repeat; patt. = pattern; tog. = together; dec. = decrease; beg. = beginning; sl. = slip; p.s.o. = pass slipped stitch over; in = inches.

## Slipover

### FRONT

\*\*With No. 11 needles and M., cast on 109 [115, 121, 127] sts.

1st row—K. 2, \* P. 1, K. 1, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

2nd row—\* K. 1, P. 1, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1. Rep. 1st and 2nd rows for 3 in., ending with 2nd row.

### Change to No. 8 needles and patt.

1st row—K. 2, \* P. 1, K. 1, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

2nd row—P. 2, \* K. 1, P. 1, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

3rd row—With A, K. to end.

4th row—P. 2, \* K. 1, M. 1A, 1M, 1A, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

5th row—K. 2, \* P. 1, 3M, 1A, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

6th row—P. 2, \* 1M, 2M, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

7th row—K. 2, \* 2M, 3A, 1M, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

8th row—P. 2, \* 1A, 2M, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

9th row—K. 2, \* 2A, 3M, 1A, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

10th row—P. 2, \* 1M, 1A, 3M, 1A, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

Now rep. the 1st to 10th rows but using B instead of A.

These 20 rows form the patt. \*\*

Work until front measures 12½ in. from cast-on edge, ending with a right side row.

**Divide for neck**  
Next row—Work 55 [58, 61, 64] sts. and slip on st-holder, work to end.

**Finish each side separately**  
Work 2 rows.

**Shape armhole and neck**  
1st row—Cast off 5 [7, 8, 10] sts., work to the last 2 sts., K. 2 tog.

2nd row—Work to end.

3rd row—Cast off 2 [2, 2, 2] sts., work to the last 2 sts., K. 2 tog.

4th row—Work to end.

Rep. 3rd and 4th rows once more.

7th row—K. 2 tog., work to the last 2 sts., K. 2 tog.

8th row—Work to end.

Rep. 7th and 8th rows 4 times more.

Work 2 rows.

Now keeping armhole edge straight, dec. 1 st. at neck edge on the next row, and then every 4th row until there are 21 [22, 24, 24] sts. left.

Work until armhole measures 8½ [8½, 8½, 8½] in. from beg. measured straight, ending at armhole edge.

*cast shape on red flannel*

**Shape shoulder**  
Keeping neck edge straight, cast off at beg. of next and alternate rows at shoulder edge 7 [7, 8, 8] sts. once, 7 [8, 8, 8] sts. once and 7 [7, 8, 8] sts. once. Slip sts. from st-holder back on to needle, but leaving the centre st. on a safety-pin for neck border.

Work 2 rows.

**Shape neck and armhole**

1st row—K. 2 tog., work to end.

2nd row—Cast off 5 [7, 8, 10] sts., work to end.

3rd row—K. 2 tog., work to end.

4th row—Cast off 2 [2, 2, 2] sts., work to end.

Rep. 3rd and 4th rows once more.

7th row—K. 2 tog., work to the last 2 sts., K. 2 tog.

8th row—Work to end.

Rep. 7th and 8th rows 4 times more.

Now complete to match first side, working 1 more row before commencing shoulder shaping.

## BACK

Follow instructions for front from \*\* to \*\*.

Work until back measures same as front up to commencement of armhole shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

## Shape armholes

Cast off at beg. of next and following rows, 5 [7, 10] sts. twice and 2 [2, 2, 2] sts. 4 times, and then dec. 1 st. at beg. of every row until there are 81 [87, 87, 89] sts. left.

Work until armholes measure same as those of front, ending with a wrong side row.

## Shape shoulders

Cast off at beg. of next and following rows, 7 [7, 8, 8] sts. twice, 7 [8, 8, 8] sts. twice and 7 [7, 8, 8] sts. twice.

Cast off 39 [39, 39, 41] remaining sts.

## ARMHOLE BORDERS

Press each piece lightly with warm iron and damp cloth.

Sew both shoulder seams.

Now with No. 11 needles and M., pick up and knit 120 [124, 126, 132] sts. round armhole edge (pick up 21 [23, 24, 26] sts. from the shaped edges at underarms, and 8 sts. for each 10 rows along the straight edges).

Work 8 rows in K1, P1 rib.

Cast off in rib.

## NECK BORDER

Using the set of 4 No. 11 double pointed needles and M., work as follows.—

**1st needle**—Pick up and knit 37 [37, 37, 39] sts. along back neck edge.

**2nd needle**—Pick up and knit 69 [69, 69, 71] sts. down left side of neck (1 st. for each row), and then K. 1, from safety-pin.

**3rd needle**—Pick up and knit 69 [69, 69, 71] sts. up right side of neck (176 [176, 176, 182] sts.).

**1st row**—(K. 1, P. 1) 52 [52, 52, 54] times; st. 1, K. 1, p.s.o., K. 1, K. 2 tog., \* P. 1, K. 1, rep. from \* to the last st., P. 1.

Work 12 more rounds in rib, dec. 1 st. on each side of st. picked up at point of V in every round.

Cast off in rib.

## TO MAKE UP

Sew side seams including armhole borders. Press seams.

## Sleeveless Jacket

### LEFT FRONT

#### Pocket lining

With No. 8 needles, cast on 31 sts.

Work in patt. as for front of slipover.

Work 31 rows.

Cut yarn and leave sts. on spare needle.

Now with No. 9 needles and M., cast on 58 [61, 64, 67] sts.

**1st row—(sizes 32 and 36 only)** K. 2, \* P. 1, K. 1, rep. from \* to end.

**1st row—(sizes 34 and 38 only)** K. 2, \* P. 1, K. 1, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

**2nd row—(sizes 32 and 36 only)** As 1st row.

**2nd row—(sizes 34 and 38 only)** \* K. 1, P. 1, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

Work 8 more rows in this way.

### Change to No. 8 needles and patt.

For **sizes 34 and 38 only**, work 30 rows in patt. as for front of slipover.

For **sizes 32 and 36 only**, work 30 rows in patt. as follows—

**1st row**—K. 2, \* 1A, 1M, rep. from \* to end.

**2nd row**—P. 2, \* 1M, 1A, rep. from \* to end.

**3rd row**—With A, K. to end.

**4th row**—P. 2, 1A, 1M, 1A, \* 2A, 1M, 1A, 1M, 1A, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

**5th row**—K. 2, \* 2A, 3M, 1A, rep. from \* to the last 4 sts., 2A, 2M.

**6th row**—P. 2, \* 1M, 2A, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

**7th row**—K. 2, \* 2M, 3A, 1M, rep. from \* to the last 4 sts., 2M, 2A.

**8th row**—P. 2, \* 1A, 2M, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

**9th row**—K. 2, \* 2A, 3M, 1A, rep. from \* to the last 4 sts., 2A, 2M.

**10th row**—P. 2, 2M, 1A, \* 1M, 1A, 3M, 1A, rep. from \* to the last st., K. 1.

Now rep. the 1st to 10th rows, but using B instead of A.

These 20 rows form the patt.

Work 10 more rows.

### Continue for all sizes

Work pocket in next 2 rows as follows—

**Next row**—Patt. 43 sts., slip last 31 sts. just worked onto a st-holder, patt. to end.

**Following row**—Patt. to end, working pocket lining sts. in place of those on st-holder.

Work 8 rows.

Dec. 1 st. at side edge on the next row, and then every 22nd row until there are 55 [58, 61, 64] sts. left.

Work until front measures 16½ in. from cast-on edge, ending at side edge.

### Shape front slope

Dec. 1 st. at centre front edge on the next row, and then every 4th row until there are 50 [53, 56, 59] sts. left.

Work 1 row.

### Shape armhole

**1st row**—Cast off 5 [7, 8, 10] sts., work to end.

**2nd row**—Work to end.

**3rd row**—Cast off 2 [2, 2, 2] sts., work to the last 2 sts., dec. 1 st.

**4th row**—Work to end.
