LOCATION

The Grand Pier is in Marine Parade, Weston super Mare, BS23 1AL Tel. 01934 620238

PARKING

There is a car park on Marine Parade near the Grand Pier. It is situated between the Oxford Corner cafe and the Premier Inn, and opposite the “Wheel” ride. Parking is £1.00 hour. If this is full there is parking around the corner in Carlton Street in a multi storey car park at about £1.10 hour.

TOILETS

There are toilets on the Grand Pier.

COST

The entry fee on to the Pier is £1.00 per head but if you tell the attendant that you are part of the c20 Group you should be allowed on the Pier at no charge.

Tea and coffee will be available when you arrive in the meeting room. The cost for this is included in the £3.00 charge we will be making for the visit to the Grand Pier.

Money will be collected on the day.

After the AGM there will be an opportunity for members to look around the Grand Pier and enjoy the facilities.
